We are still waiting for Enforsys to get the NFRIS set up on the Captains Computer. R. Cain Jr. mentioned he would like to have the Fire Official R. Schmitt look into other vendors that are approved by the State for our NFRIS and Fire Prevention Inspections.

Discussion for the 2017 Budget; Chief Schmitt supplied his wish list for 2017. Chief Schmitt said they are working on specifications for a new truck for 2018. R. Cain Jr. said the NFPA Standard 1901 is supposed to be effective 2017 and it will require every engine you purchase to have a 75 foot aerial. D. Hainzl will get prices for October's meeting for two new portable radios for Otto Gauweiler and Rocky Trifari. Chief Schmitt requested a 2% increase in the clothing allowance payout.

R. Cain Jr. suggested paving the parking lot Station No. 1. We will begin getting prices now for the spring.
